3 APPROVED CHANGE

3.1 BRIEF OVERVIEW OF CHANGE

This Approved Cataloging Data Change (ACDC) documents the addition of two new Major Organizational Entity (MOE) Rules MVV4 and MVV5 as requested by the USMC, in which USMC acts as the Secondary Inventory Control Activity (SICA) and the U.S. Air Force (USAF) as the Primary Inventory Control Activity (PICA).

3.2 APPROVED CHANGE IN DETAIL

Per Cataloging Data and Transaction Standards, Volume 13, Chapter 6, "The MOE Rule Table, Appendix 13-6-B, reflects management responsibilities within participating Military Services, Civil Agencies, and NATO and other foreign countries. The information included in the MOE Rules is a combination of Department of Defense (DoD) and Service/Agency cataloging/supply management assignments which are made on the basis of organizational responsibilities."

The USMC requested the addition of two new MOE Rules MVV4 and MVV5 in which they are the SICA and the USAF is listed as the PICA.

The PICA and SICA MOE Rules drive business rules for what a user can and cannot do on a National Stock Number (NSN). With this addition, the USAF can support the USMC as a user on NSNs where the USMC SICA MOE Rule is present. This support includes but may not be limited to providing assets from stock and specific means and/or location for the repair of items.

The new MOE Rules have been added to FLIS DB2 Table 093, MOE_RULE_TBL with an effective date of 2019022.

The Enterprise Business Standards Office (EBSO) will update the documentation in Cataloging Data and Transaction Standards, Volume 13, Appendix 13-6-B to reflect the addition.

3.3 REASON FOR CHANGE

In accordance with FLIS Technical Procedure, Volume 6, Section 6.3.11, the USMC must be recorded as a SICA User in order to be supported by USAF. If the rules are not established, the system will reject transactions with the new MOE Rules if they are not loaded. Subsequently, USMC would not be able to order, repair, or turn-in stock from/to USAF without being recognized as an authorized SICA user.

3.4 REVISIONS TO CATALOGING DATA AND TRANSACTION STANDARDS

This change requires an update to the information in Cataloging Data and Transaction Standards, Volume 13, Appendix 13-6-B and is identified in the Enclosure.
