3 REQUESTED CHANGE

3.1 BRIEF OVERVIEW OF CHANGE

The Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) system is updating its list of debarbing agencies or Debarment Proposal Initiators. This data is currently present in Volume 10.

3.2 REQUESTED CHANGE IN DETAIL

3.2.1 Background

The Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) Code is comprised of five-characters and used throughout the Federal government. Assigned by the Department of Defense's Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), the CAGE Code supports numerous systems and provides a standard method of identifying a given legal entity at a specific location, allowing an entity to do business with the government.

The System for Award Management (SAM) is the authoritative source on agencies authorized to debar vendors from doing business with the government. The CAGE program office currently receives debarbing data updates for CAGE codes directly from SAM and passes them to FLIS via the CAGE DRDA internal feed.

3.2.2 Changes to Cataloging Data and Transaction Standards, Volume 10, Table 183

The debarbing agencies are found in CDTS Volume 10, Table 183, as Debarment Proposal Symbols (agency acronyms) and Proposal Initiators (full agency name). The fields and their attributes will remain the same, but the CAGE program office will be adding new/updating existing Debarment Proposal Symbols and Initiators (i.e. CIA - Central Intelligence Agency). A full list of changes is located in Enclosure 1.

3.3 REASON FOR CHANGE

At present, the debarbing agency data is out of sync between SAM, CAGE, and FLIS/FLIS Volume 10. SAM currently has over 80 debarbing agencies, but CAGE only has 28 and CDTS Volume 10, Table 183 contains only 34.

This creates instances where an authorized agency has debarred a vendor, but CAGE and its downstream systems do not recognize/reflect the specific agency initiating the action.

This change will update the CAGE system, and ultimately Volume 10 so that the data is in sync with the authoritative source.

Please note this data discrepancy does not currently prevent CAGE from sending FLIS notices that CAGEs have been debarred/are no longer debarred (i.e. CAGE Status changes).

3.4 REVISIONS TO CATALOGING DATA AND TRANSACTION STANDARDS
