### **Defense Enterprise Data Standards Office (DEDSO) Meeting Notes**

## **PQDR**

Date: March 5, 2025

### I. PURPOSE

The Defense Enterprise Data Standards Office (DEDSO) received formal concurrence from the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Logistics on Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) Change (ADC) 1443 Product Quality Deficiency Report (PQDR) policy migration. ADC 1443 was signed on 27 January 2023, and this ADC serves to inform the Department of Defense (DoD) Components that the Defense Logistics Manual (DLM) 4000.25, Volume 2, Chapter 24, is replacing Joint Service Regulation (JSR) Defense Logistics Agency Regulation (DLAR) 4155.24/AR 702-7/SECNAVINST 4855.21/AFI 21-115/DCMA INST 1102 as the DoD's authoritative source for PQDR-related guidance.

### III. AGENDA ITEMS

### 1. <u>DEDSO PQDR Administrator Transition:</u>

Mark Rockwell, outgoing DEDSO PQDR Administrator, announced his retirement and expressed his appreciation for the hard work and support of the PQDR committee during his tenure. Mark then reintroduced Ben Breen as the new DEDSO PQDR Lead. Ben spoke briefly, highlighting the crossover collaboration between Supply Discrepancy Reporting (SDR) and PQDR in the past and his excitement to continue the battle rhythm to finalize the ongoing key PQDR committee initiatives. DEDSO reiterated the requirement for receiving updated appointment letters, as it was noted that other committee members had imminent retirement or transitions plans.

### 2. Proposed DLMS Change (PDC) 1443C PQDR Policy Migration:

Mark Rockwell reviewed the status of the continuation of the PQDR policy migration via PDC 1443C, initially intended to have a kick-off meeting during the previously planned DLMS summit in April, 2025. However, in light of the recent DoD workforce initiatives, the summit is being postponed and will most likely be held virtually at a future date.

Mark ultimately deferred to Ben for any revised start dates for PDC 1443C development. Mark shared his initial intent to begin deliberations by reviewing the previous ADC 1443B comments that required full committee discussion, as well as seeking resolution on transportation charges, time standards, and any other areas that were in the JSR that have not yet been migrated to DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, Chapter 24.

## 3. <u>Implementation of ADC 1007E DLMS 842P Procedures, Business Rules, Data Elements, and Coding Updates:</u>

Mark stressed the continued importance of the Naval Supply Systems Command led technical team implementation efforts and restated that testing will continue with a target implementation date of February 2026.

Mark briefed that DEDSO continues to track deficiencies discovered by the technical team during the process and will consolidate all the required changes in PDC 1007F to allow implementation to continue.

### 4. PDC 1446B Security Assistance (SA) SDR/PQDR:

Mark provided a recap of the International Logistics Control Office appointment letters received to include Defense Security Cooperation Agency as participants for development of this joint PDC. DEDSO stated that the goal for development of this PDC would be six months prior to the 842P transactions implementation for timing and alignment.

### 5. Save-the-Date:

### a. DLMS Summit:

Mark briefed that, considering current events, DEDSO has decided to transition the DLMS Summit to a virtual event with dates to be determined. DEDSO will be posting specifics and new dates on our website, through our newsletter, and the PRCs and working groups.
