I. PURPOSE

The Defense Enterprise Data Standards Office (DEDSO) received formal concurrence from the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Logistics on Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) Change (ADC) 1443 Product Quality Deficiency Report (PQDR) Policy Migration. ADC 1443 was signed on 27 January 2023 and this ADC serves to inform the Department of Defense (DoD) Components that the Defense Logistics Manual (DLM) 4000.25, Volume 2, Chapter 24, is replacing Joint Service Regulation Defense Logistics Agency Regulation 4155.24/AR 702-7/SECNAVINST 4855.21/AFI 21-115/DCMA INST 1102 as the DoD authoritative source for PQDR-related guidance.

1. <u>DEDSO PQDR Battle Rhythm Change:</u>

Mr. Ben Breen, DEDSO PQDR Administrator, proposed a time change for the DoD PQDR committee meetings. The meeting will remain bi-weekly on Wednesdays, but will start 30 minutes later beginning at 1400 and ending at 1500. The change was communicated to all involved via e-mail.

3. <u>Implementation of ADC 1007E DLMS 842P Procedures, Business Rules, Data Elements, and Coding Update:</u>

Ben briefed his intent to stay engaged with the technical team meetings to answer any questions or comments, while reiterating that he and Steve Nace would continue to capture and track any requirements for the development of PDC /ADC 1007F to support the 842P implementation.

During the meeting discussions, Air Force Security Assistance and Cooperation Directorate members in attendance requested to join the technical team meeting discussions. Invites were coordinated with the technical team lead.

4. PDC 1446B Security Assistance (SA) Supply Discrepancy Reporting (SDR)/PQDR:

Ben Breen reminded the committee that the development of this PDC was contingent on the 842P business rules development. Therefore, if the 842P implementation "Go-live" date remains on track, he cited the August timeframe to begin documenting and codifying the process for foreign military sales (FMS) customers to transition quality related issues from SDR to PQDR. Ben recapped agenda topics to be discussed at the next meeting, commended the committee's efforts to date, and expressed appreciation for the flexibility in the battle rhythm change.
