#### I. PURPOSE

The Defense Enterprise Data Standards Office (DEDSO) received formal concurrence from the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Logistics ODASD(Log) on Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) Change (ADC) 1443 Product Quality Deficiency Report (PQDR) Policy Migration. ADC 1443 was signed on 27 January 2023. This ADC serves to inform the Department of Defense (DoD) Components that the Defense Logistics Manual (DLM) 4000.25, Volume 2, Chapter 24, is replacing Joint Service Regulation Defense Logistics Agency Regulation 4155.24/AR 702-7/SECNAVINST 4855.21/AFI 21-115/DCMA INST 1102 as the DoD authoritative source for PQDR-related guidance.

### **III. AGENDA ITEMS**

### a. Proposed DLMS Change (PDC) 1443C PQDR Policy Migration:

Ben Breen, PQDR Administrator informed the committee of the Technical Implementation Working Group process flow discussions from a systems perspective for transaction status updates, retention of DLMS implementation convention (IC) qualifiers with future foreign military sales (FMS) implications and the proposed addition of Joint Deficiency Reporting System (JDRS) PQDR cancelation codes.

Ben also discussed major versus minor data element changes and proposed program changes for the flow of transactions for minor changes from the linear hierarchical reporting approach of one level up/one level down for status updates to a more flexible functionality that perpetuates the information via WebPQDR to all other systems simultaneously to keep them all in sync.

## **Defense Enterprise Data Standards Office Meeting Notes**

Ben again extended the review period for Proposed DLMS Change (PDC) 1443C, noting the intent was to wrap up submissions and have a final draft for committee review and staffing in the next few months.

Ben inquired about the status of travel authorizations for the proposed face-to-face process review committee (PRC) primary/alternate representative meeting with the technical implementation group the week of 23 June 2025 in Patuxent River, Maryland. U.S. Navy stated they were approved to travel, while others reporting pending approval status or denial. It was determined that a virtual option would be made available to facilitate PQDR system technical implementation for the three major IT systems (JDRS, Enterprise Business System, and Product Data Reporting and Evaluation Program).

DEDSO acknowledged the continued change of personnel by the different DoD Components, but again requested that updated appointment letters be submitted as soon as possible to maintain the accuracy of the PQDR distribution list.
