I. PURPOSE

The Defense Enterprise Data Standards Office (DEDSO) received formal concurrence from the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Logistics ODASD(Log) on Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) Change (ADC) 1443 Product Quality Deficiency Report (PQDR) Policy Migration. ADC 1443 was signed on 27 January 2023. This ADC serves to inform the DoD Components that the Defense Logistics Manual (DLM) 4000.25, Volume 2, Chapter 24, is replacing Joint Service Regulation Defense Logistics Agency Regulation 4155.24/AR 702-7/SECNAVINST 4855.21/AFI 21-115/DCMA INST 1102 as the DoD authoritative source for PQDR-related guidance.

IV. AGENDA ITEMS

- **a.** <u>ServiceNow Ticketing Process</u>: Ben Breen, PQDR Administrator, reminded Components to use ServiceNow for requests, updates, and submissions and informed them of the link and the available user's guide to assist.
- **b.** <u>PDC 1007F Changes</u>: Ben briefed that informal review comments, with a few exceptions, had been accepted and that an updated document would be sent back out with changes highlighted in green. The final step would be for the Technical Writer to review before submission to the DEDSO Director for signature.
- **c.** <u>PDC 1443C PQDR Policy Migration</u>: Ben stated the updated policy migration would include Chapter 24 revisions, with some sections moved around for clarity, as well as appendix updates to include file attachments and formatting. Some open discussion is still needed on the parent/child relationship process before finalizing.
- **d.** <u>Parent/Child PQDR Discussion</u>: It was discussed that a meeting will be held to get a better understanding of the parent-child relationship process due to inconsistencies in how different components handle open versus closed child PQDRs. Also, clarity was needed to clearly distinguish child PQDRs versus repetitive PQDRs.
- **e.** <u>**DLMS Summit:**</u> The virtual DLMS Summit date is still to be determined. DEDSO will be posting agenda and new dates on our website, through our newsletter, and via the Process Review Committees and working groups.
