V. Agenda Items.

1. DLMS 869A versus DLMS 869F

- (Updated 2/18/2026) DEDSO informed the group that when looking at a data pull of DLMS 869A/869F transactions, both were found to be widely used. Based on the information received and the research that was conducted, DEDSO is closing out this inquiry.
 - Marine Corps
 - Air Force
 - USSOCOM
 - DLA
- (Updated 1/21/2026) DEDSO for feedback on how Components are using these transactions, are Components using both transactions?
- (Updated 1/21/2026)- Army and Navy have provided feedback on their use of these transactions.
- Army provided via email: 869A vs. 869F uses with MILSVCs:
 - i. Army sends DLMS 869A (AF*) when following up to a requisition and a supply status has been received (i.e. BA, BB, BD, etc.,). If DLMS 869A is received by Army and no open order/requisition exists, then BF status is provided and no order is built.
 - ii. Army sends DLMS 869F (AT*) when following up to a requisition when no supply status has been received. If a DLMS 869F is received by Army and no open order in our system, then we build the order and provide proper status.
- Navy provided via email- Navy uses both transactions, however, validating if Navy sends to external components

2. Annual Supply Process Review Committee Appointment Letter Updates

- The group was reminded about updating appointments. DAAS asked where DEDSO was on the new formatting of the appointment letter that would allow for multiple PRCs/CMBs to be picked on a single appointment. DEDSO informed the working group that the form is being developed but has not yet been approved. DEDSO will follow up with DAAS and provide the updated template once approved.

3. DLMS 867I (Issue) Transaction Set Use

- (Updated 2/17/2026) DEDSO reminded those who have not yet provided feedback on the use of the DLMS 867I that this is still an open action.
- (Updated 1/21/2026)—Ms. Dew from Army provided feedback to DEDSO supply via email on DLMS 867I
- ARMY: DLMS 867I: Army does not utilize inbound DLMS 867I (D7*) transactions. We do not need those transactions from storage activities. We do provide outbound DLMS 867I (D7*) to Other Services for scenarios where we store their inventory and issue it out.
- (Updated 12/10/2025) DEDSO requested the supply trading partners assist them by going back internally to determine who exactly is using the DLMS 867I transaction set, and for what purpose.
- (Updated 12/10/2025) DLA mentioned that they are currently looking at end-of-day reporting (DLMS 846I (Asset Status Inquiry and Reporting), which is also tied to some DLA NFRs. Research so far has concluded that there are many inconsistencies and imbalance issues taking place. DLA's preference is that the 867I be sent to all systems when the MRO is sent to a DLA storage activity. DLA's warehousing system is using system logic based on the MRO owner details and correlating it to their owner balances, and that is the basis for DLA storage activities to send the outbound transaction. However, the transaction is not sent out to all owners and there are questions about how often the warehousing system tables listing DLMS 867I recipients are being updated.
- (Updated 12/10/2025) Army informed the group that they drop inventory (decrement the inventory record balance) based on the DLMS 945A (Materiel Release Advice) transaction versus the DLMS 867I.
- (Updated 12/10/2025) As a follow up to that, a DEDSO participant stated that adjusting balances off being informed that property has been released makes the most logical sense. Additionally, DEDSO asked DLA if an MRO owner has an inventory balance, which triggers DLMS 867I (when programmed), but if no physical property exists in that location at the time of the materiel pick, causing a DLMS 945A denial, how does DLMS 867I get corrected? Is the DLMS 846I end of day balance used to update the erroneous DLMS 867I?
- (Updated 12/10/2025) DLA informed that no 846I is sent to correct an inaccurate 867I, but for Navy/Air Force a D7_ reversal is sent.

4. DoD Components provide DEDSO with some APSR POCs to participate in a meeting to discuss new GFP-related Product ID changes for the DLMS 947I (PDC 1515)

- DEDSO informed the working group that OASW(A)/DPCAP intends to brief this new DLMS 947I reason for inventory adjustment at the next two LOGIT PCAT meetings. This ensures that the information is shared with the DoW information technology (IT) portfolio community. However, DEDSO believes that while informing the IT portfolio managers helps spread the word, they would still like to continue with their plan on providing an update to the SPRC. The IT system personnel that the SPRC works with on a regular basis, as these specific individuals have a more detailed working knowledge of the inventory adjustment process.

5. DEDSO Summit Topics – PRC Community
