ODASW(Log) Intent: ICW DEDSO, provide sound policy and strategic-level oversight to standardize the business processes, procedures, and electronic data formats for logistics operations across the DoW:

- Support proposed Defense Logistics Management Standards changes (PDCs) in development, provide OSW perspective, avoid surprises
- Integrate with OSW PSAs outside OUSW(A&S), as required
- Staff approved DLMS changes (ADCs) with ODASW(Log) SMEs, obtain timely DASW(Log) approval
- Maintain awareness of DLMS life cycle
- Incorporate intelligent automation when feasible



Success Factors: To facilitate ODASW(Log) validation and approval, DLMS Change Attachments¹ should:

- Balance level of specificity between 2. REASON FOR CHANGE, 3. BOTTOM LINE UP FRONT (BLUF), and 4. CHANGE IN DETAIL
- Provide context when referencing a previous DLMS change
- Include an example in the BLUF; this helps us tell your story

Category	Input	Process	Output
Coordination	PDC Comment Matrix	Demonstrate Component-level coordination	Answer hard questions from DASW(Log), help us help you when OSW guidance is required
Selective Highlighting	Use of highlighting and font color to show linkages	Helps OSW organizations see connections within a PDC, and to other DLMS changes	Integration on aspects of your DLMS change that may be obvious to you, but are less clear for OSW staff who do not live DLMS all day, every day
Financial Improvement and Audit Readiness (FIAR)	9. FIAR Material Weakness (MW) ¹	Make Audit-relevant information clear and complete	FIAR is a Department-level priority; when applicable make ties to MW(s), Notices of Findings and Recommendations (NFRs) and Corrective Action Plans (CAPs) clear
