- **Services need to know how to prioritize Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) changes**
- **Access to Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS) testing information**
- **Get conversations at the right level**
- **Better access to meeting minutes**
- **Better reports**
- **Expand proposed DLMS change (PDC)/ approved DLMS change (ADC) cross-process awareness**
- **Increase visibility of Process Review Committees (PRCs)**

Make Implementation Easier

- **PDC & ADC Bottom Line Up Front (BLUF) sections need improvement; clearer indication of impact**
- **Request for requirements documents**
- **Better tracking of who is implementing what, when, and the associated costs**
- **Baselining**
- **Metadata tagging**
- **Tie PDC/ADC reviews to workflow**

Get the Right People the Right Information

- ✓ **Created filters on ADC and Implementation Convention website pages to quickly ID Audit, G-Invoicing, Standard Financial Information Structure/Standard Line of Accounting, and Unique Item tracking changes**
 - ✓ **Share related ADCs with LOG IT Working Group**
 - ✓ **Implementation tracked in LOGIT PCAT**
- ✓ **DAAS testing e-mail in DLMS changes**
- ✓ **Shifted from PRCs to Working Groups for more tactical level work**
- ✓ **LOGIT-PCAT reporting and tracking**
- ✓ **Military Standard Logistics System/DLMS report sharing**
- ✓ **LOG IT Working Group**
- ✓ **Newsletter/website posts PDCs in progress**
- ✓ **PRC Committee Matrix on website**
- ✓ **Gamechanger (here and gone...)**

What we did...

Get the Right People the Right Information

- ✓ **Brought project codes back to the website**
- ✓ **Added regular cadence to training sessions**
- ✓ **Built out additional training slides for the website**
- ✓ **Reduced administrative time by cutting out coordination steps.**
- ✓ **Implemented quicker DLM updates**
- ✓ **Dedicated an entire webpage for DLMS cataloging support**
- ✓ **Teamed with ODASW(L) to pilot SDR data into the War Data platform (Kaleidoscope)**
- ✓ **Partnered with Defense Transportation Electronic Business (DTEB) committee to improve standardization and data sharing**
- ✓ **Executed a massive data qualifier clean up**
- ✓ **Created access to unaltered X12 transactions in WebSDR**

What we did...

Make Implementation Easier

- ✓ **Multiple changes to our PDC/ADC templates to bring critical info up front**
- ✓ **ADC Clean up:**
 - ✓ **Reviewed ADCs and identified 96 as fully implemented. More reviews in progress!**
 - ✓ **Withdrew 3 ADCs that were OBE.**
- ✓ **Added specificity to DLMS changes by identifying impacted systems via DITPR**
- ✓ **Built transaction to DLM maps**
- ✓ **Developing “implementation packages”**
- ✓ **LOGIT PCAT is collecting all your implementation inputs!**
- ✓ **Efforts to clean up the Defense Logistics Manual 4000.25**

Get the Right People the Right Information

Make Implementation Easier

- **Who remembers the DocuSign Contract Lifecycle Management (CLM) hoopla? It is still coming...**
 - Updates to PDC/ADC structure to more quickly find what YOU need
 - Better flagging of ADC “type” (e.g., admin, system change, policy, code update, critical priority, Notice of Finding and Recommendation)
 - Better identification of impacted Services/systems
 - Integrate the Comment Matrix into DocuSign coordination
 - Ability to track extension requests
 - Reporting check in/reminders for testing, funding, and implementation status
 - Link to LOGIT-PCAT via API for better reporting visibility
 - Ability to coordinate/notify additional PRC/ Configuration Management Boards on a “need-to-know” basis
 - Ability to sync with ServiceNow for potential workflow integration
