<b>Requirements</b>	<p>The explosives safety status of MPPEH must be determined by:</p> <p>(a) 100-percent visual inspection and an independent 100-percent re-inspection by qualified personnel;</p> <p>(b) Processing by a DDESB-approved method with appropriate post-processing inspection (e.g., sampling) of the material; or</p> <p>(c) Application of DoD Component-approved expert knowledge. A certification or verification statement as shown must be signed and dated by a DoD contracted person or a government employee.</p> <p>This documentation is only valid if the material listed is properly segregated and secured, and the chain of custody is maintained until the material's release from DoD control.</p>
