

## Who is eligible?

Schools and educational nonprofit organizations located in the United States, U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands can receive computer equipment through the CFL Program.

A school is eligible to participate if it is a public, private or parochial school serving some portion of the prekindergarten through grade 12 population. Day care centers must provide a state approved preschool curriculum in order to participate.

## What is the cost?
