

Parties mutually agree that the Agency sites listed below which are currently covered under the East Contract between the Parties will be treated as RIP locations on the Mid America contract, even though the sites are outside the allowable geographic location in the IFB 33-3081 Mid-America contract.

- Susquehanna
- Richmond
- Meade

All property eligible for sale at these sites listed above will be sourced to the Mid-America Contract (33-3081).

All financial terms and conditions in the Mid America contract will apply to these sales at the above listed sites, excluding the Bid % Sales price of 3.66%, but instead retaining the Bid % Sales price of 3.5% from the original STS East Usable Sales Contract (21-069) that the above listed sites were included.

All property removal times terms and conditions in the Mid America contract will apply to these sales at the above listed sites.

Purchasers right to refuse items based on \$3 million dollars OAV in the Mid America contract will apply to property at the above listed sites.

The Agency will provide the same level of support for loading and MHE to the Purchaser at the sites listed above, as it provides under the STS East contract.

This Modification to the Mid America Contract will NOT include an increase to the minimum and or maximum OAV/DTID's.

The following General Statement paragraph #7 (pg. 9) and #10 (pg. 10) is modified to say:

This IFB relates to personal property assets that the Agency has determined to be surplus to the needs of the Department of Defense and the Federal Government. Property in the Mid-America Region which includes all Disposition Services and Receipt in Place Sites in the Agency's Mid-America Region which includes Arkansas, Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas and to include the following three (3) sites in the East: Susquehanna, Richmond and Meade as Receipt in Place locations. The geographic region in this IFB is significantly different from regions used in past STS or CV IFBs and all bidders are advised to use caution when comparing prior sales information that may not align with this geographic region.

In the Mid-America Region which includes all Disposition Services and Receipt in Place Sites in the Agency's Mid-America Region which includes Arkansas, Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas and to include the following three (3) sites in the East: Susquehanna, Richmond and Meade as Receipt in Place locations. DLA Disposition Services sites may also receive property that is not located at a DLA Disposition Services facility and may refer for sale to the Purchaser at a "Receipt in Place" (RIP) location within the geographic areas included within the awarded contract.

The following Item Description paragraph #2 (pg. 15) is modified to say:

The property will be comprised of surplus personal property at sites in the Mid-America Region which includes all Disposition Services and Receipt in Place Sites in the Agency's Mid-America Region which includes Arkansas, Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas and to include the following three (3) sites in the East: Susquehanna, Richmond and Meade as Receipt in Place locations.

The following terms and conditions will apply to IFB Sale 33-3081:

1. Article Eight, Section 4 – Property Referrals, is modified as follows:

Property that is referred for sale to the Purchaser shall be located at Agency field sites and Receipt in Place (RIP) facilities. RIP locations are facilities where the Agency has received property without physically relocating it to an Agency field site. Agency and RIP locations included in this sale are located in the Mid-America region of the United States which include: Arkansas, Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas and to include the following three (3) sites in the East: Susquehanna, Richmond and Meade as Receipt in Place locations.

The Government has sole discretion to determine when and what material shall be issued to the Purchaser, and the Purchaser has a contractual obligation to purchase and accept all material referred by the Government as specified in the contract. The Purchaser is not required to take hazardous material or material that could pose a risk to national security, environmental or personnel safety or health issue such as mold and asbestos containing materials. The Agency reserves the right to sell material or offer material through alternative sales or contract means for all material not considered part of this contract.

Purchaser acknowledges that during the performance period of this contract, changes in Government processes or procedures could result in large generations of property being received by the Agency which could ultimately be referred under this contract. The Agency and the Purchaser agree to cooperate and institute special procedures as necessary in connection with property surges. The Purchaser shall not expect any other type of relief that is based solely upon or related in any manner to an unanticipated level of effort or additional effort necessary to the handling of such influx in property.

2. Article Ten, Section 10, Sub-section 3 – Request for Reimbursable Emergency and Extraordinary Costs:
Any additional cost to Purchaser will NOT be eligible for reimbursement due to this Modification to include the above listed sites added to the Mid America Contract.
3. Article Eleven, Section 2, Sub-section 2 – Controlled Property Storage:
Purchaser may use its storage facilities and personnel located in the East to process this property.
4. This is a temporary agreement Modification and may be cancelled at any time by either party with 45 calendar days notice.

5. This Modification will automatically terminate upon issuance of a new Usable Sales East contract.
6. All other terms and conditions in IFB sale 33-3081 remain in-place.
