Lundy has an extensive background with more than 20 years in the transportation field. This includes time with supply, warehousing and inventory experience. Lundy served as the warehouse manager of a private industry auto parts wholesaler for more than five years. She also served with the Army in logistics for four years and the Army Reserve for six.



She has been with the Defense Logistics Agency for nine years, starting at DLA Distribution Susquehanna, Pennsylvania, then working in J3 (VSM), J4 Transportation Policy, DLA Distribution Bahrain and J6 (VSM system analyst).

Most recently, Lundy worked for the Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command, 595th Transportation Brigade Ocean Cargo Clearance Authority Southwest Asia in Bahrain. Lundy first served as the booking lead ordering officer and later the OCCA-SWA chief.
