Commander Joseph H. Peth is a native of Guyton, Georgia, and is an alumnus of Georgia Southern University. He earned a Master of Business Administration with a concentration in Supply Chain Management from the Naval Post Graduate School and a Master of Science degree in Joint Campaign Planning and Strategy from the Joint Forces Staff College.

He enlisted in the United States Navy in 1987 and served on the USS Excel (MSO-439), COOPMINEUNIT 2209 at Savannah, Georgia, and IBU27 at Charleston, South Carolina. He was selected for the Officer Candidate Program in Pensacola, Florida, and received his commission as a Navy Supply Corps Officer in June 2000.



His afloat tours include disbursing officer on the USS Taylor (FFG 50) and supply officer on the USS Lake Erie (CG 70).
