James J. Lucowitz Jr., became the deputy director of DLA Distribution Barstow, California, on August 18, 2019. Lucowitz has over 20 years of Department of Defense experience in army sustainment, logistics, transportation and supply distribution operations management. Lucowitz holds a Master of Science degree in Logistics Management from the Florida Institute of Technology and a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration Management from Norwich University.



Most recently, Lucowitz served as supervisor, logistics management specialist, 916th Support Brigade, Fort Irwin, California. He was responsible for the planning, coordination, and synchronization of Theater Level Sustainment Operations for 10 National Training Center rotations annually to include; theater opening, theater distribution and theater closing operations. Lucowitz was also responsible for the successful reception and redeployment of 15,000 pieces of equipment and 50,000 personnel per year at an annual cost of \$132 million. Before that, he worked as a logistics management specialist for the 916th Support Brigade where he was also responsible for 10 NTC rotations. In addition, he oversaw day-to-day logistical distribution and resupply operations for all supply commodity areas, successfully executing over 3,000 missions annually to include; rations, ice, water, fuel, ammunition, repair parts and field services valued in excess of \$65 million annually.
