

DLA Distribution Cherry Point, North Carolina Mr. Robert "Kevin" Taylor Director

Robert "Kevin" Taylor started his federal career in 1984 as a temporary worker at the Naval Aviation Depot, Cherry Point, North Carolina. In 1985, he was selected for a permanent position in the Inventory Department, Supply Directorate, MCAS Cherry Point, North Carolina.

Taylor progressively assumed increased responsibility and in 1997, he became the Supervisor of the Inventory Integrity Division, Distribution Depot, Cherry Point, North Carolina. In 1998, he was a team member that prepared DDCN for the implementation of Defense Supply System. In 1999, he was a cadre member for the A-76 competition and in 2000, was instrumental in writing the PWS for the PPP&M satellite sites imbedded in the local Naval Aviation Depot.



In 2001, Taylor became the Deputy Commander of DDCN. At the conclusion of the A-76 competition in 2001, it was determined that DDCN would be outsourced to a commercial activity. Mr. Taylor worked closely with the DDC Transition Team, DDC Contracting Office, DDC Personnel Office, DDCN employees, and the incoming contractor to assure a smooth transition from a government run activity to a commercially contracted site.

Taylor assumed Command of DLA Distribution Cherry Point, NC on June 10, 2009 as Director.

Taylor earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration at East Carolina University in 1983. He is the recipient of numerous special service, incentive, and unit awards.
