LTC Justin McGovern graduated from The Citadel in Charleston, South Carolina in 2003 and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Transportation Corps with a branch detail to the Chemical Corps.

His first assignment was with 2-70 Armor Battalion, 3rd Brigade, 1st AD, Fort Riley, Kansas, where he served as the Battalion Chemical Officer and Assistant S3 and deployed in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM. Following the Combined Logistics Captain's Career Course LTC McGovern became the Support Operations Office Transportation Officer in 4th BCT, 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, North Carolina. Soon after his arrival he deployed in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM. While deployed he took command of Delta Troop (Forward Support Company) 4-73 Cavalry, 4th BCT 82nd Airborne Division. He continued to command Delta Troop through the training progression and once again deployed to Afghanistan. Following successful command of Delta Troop he took command of Alpha Company, 782nd Brigade Support Battalion 4th BCT 82nd Airborne Division. Following his command of Alpha Company LTC McGovern was assigned to the TRADOC HQ at Fort Eustis, Virginia, where he served as an operations officer inside the G3/5/7's personnel proponents division.

Following completion of the Command and General Staff College LTC McGovern became the Division Transportation Officer for the 82nd Airborne Division. Immediately following his assignment as the DTO he became the Battalion Executive Officer for the 82nd Brigade Support Battalion, 3rd BCT, 82nd Airborne Division and deployed to Iraq in support of OPERATION INHERENT RESOLVE.

Following his assignment as the BSB XO LTC McGovern served in the NATO Special Operations HQs at SHAPE, Belgium as the deputy chief of staff. Following this assignment he was selected to conduct futures research for the Chief of Staff of the Army's Strategic Studies Group on the Army staff. After this one year fellowship LTC McGovern was chosen to be the Brigade S4 for establishment and deployment to Afghanistan for the 1st Security Force Assistance Brigade at Fort Benning, Georgia.

LTC McGovern's civilian education consists of a Master of Business Administration in Supply Chain Management from the University of Kansas and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice from The Citadel.

His military education includes the Command and General Staff College, Combined Logistics Captain Career Course, Chemical Officer basic course, Jumpmaster Course, and Airborne School.
