

Christopher Witter became deputy commander of Defense Logistics Agency Distribution Sigonella, Italy, in July 2024.

He arrived at DDSI in March 2023 as the Chief of Operations, where he led the Operations Division through a year of unprecedented workload resulting from the simultaneous in-theater presence of two Carrier Strike Groups and an Amphibious Readiness Group, as well as the DDSI transition to the Warehouse Management System

Witter began his time with DLA upon his arrival at DDSI after 34 years with the US Air Force where he held positions ranging from Team Leader to Group Commander. His career has encompassed time on Active Duty, as an Air

Reserve Technician, Traditional Reservist, Air Guardsman, officer and enlisted and Civil Service positions ranging from GS-9 to GS-14. He currently maintains senior officer rank in the Inactive Ready Reserve.

He has had numerous assignments ranging from Korea to Alaska with stops between in Nebraska, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana and New York.
