



DLA Distribution Warner Robins, Ga. Mr. Ken Dinero Acting Deputy Director

A native of Flushing, New York, Ken Dinero became acting deputy director, DLA Distribution Warner Robins, Georgia, in January 2019.

Dinero joined the Navy in March 1991, was commissioned in December 2000, and served four tours at sea: USS Constellation (CV-64), USS Essex (LHD-2), supply officer on the USS Bremerton (SSN-698) and material officer on the USS John C Stennis (CVN-74). He had one expeditionary assignment at Joint Contingency Contracting Command, Baghdad, Iraq, along with shore assignments as a NACO Intern, Naval Inventory Control Point, Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania, and deputy director at Fleet Logistics Center, Gulfport, Mississippi. He retired after 21 year of service as a Navy Supply Corps lieutenant commander.



Prior to his current assignment, Dinero served as the Operations Group Chief for DLA Distribution Warner Robins, Georgia, one of the five largest distribution centers in the DLA Distribution network. Dinero was directly responsible for 130,000 line items valued at \$11 billion stored across three million square feet of real estate in 22 storage warehouses/lots. His 400 person team provided worldwide support by issuing and receiving approximately one million lines annually.

Dinero received a bachelor's degree in business from New Hampshire College. He also holds a master's degree in business administration from Rice University and a master's degree in national security and strategic studies from the United States Naval War College and has numerous personal awards.
