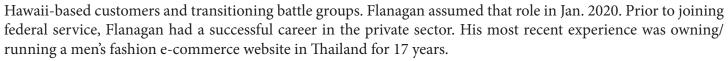


DLA Distribution Europe Mr. Neil G. Flanagan Deputy Commander
