

Ms. Karen D. Lundy, a Pennsylvania native, assumed her current position as the deputy commander for DLA Distribution Europe on DATE.

Lundy has an extensive background with more than 20 years in the transportation field. This includes time with supply, warehousing and inventory experience. Lundy served as the warehouse manager of a private industry auto parts wholesaler for more than five years. She also served with the Army in logistics for four years and the Army Reserve for six.

She has been with the Defense Logistics Agency for 15 years, starting at DLA Distribution Susquehanna, Pennsylvania, then working in J3 (VSM), J4 Transportation Policy, DLA Distribution Bahrain and J6 (VSM system analyst). She also worked for the Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command, 595th Transportation Brigade Ocean Cargo Clearance Authority Southwest Asia in Bahrain for two and a half years before returning to DLA Distribution as the DLA Distribution Bahrain, Southwest Asia, deputy commander.

Most recently, Lundy worked for DLA Distribution Network Integration on the Future Operations and Integration Team. Lundy first served as the booking lead ordering officer and later the OCCA-SWA chief. In this supervisory position, she oversaw the processing of over 32,000 pieces of cargo transiting the Central Command area of responsibility as well as performing quality assurance. She served as a contracting officer representative on inbound/outbound commercial shipments. She approved invoices worth \$7.4 million and short paying with a cost avoidance of \$794,000.

Lundy has received several awards including the 2022 Global Distribution Excellence Award for High Performer of the Year, DLA Exceptional Civilian Service Award, the Commander's Award for Public Service and various certificates of achievement and commander's coins.
