James (Jim) McArthur is the Director of DLA Distribution Hill, Utah.

McArthur is responsible for the supply distribution facility providing wholesale and retail logistical support to a variety of customers within the Department of Defense and the Ogden Air Logistics Center with an inventory worth an excess of \$10 billion.

A native of Utah, McArthur graduated from Weber State University with a Bachelor of Science in political science with a minor in aeronautical science. Additionally, he holds a master's degree from Embry-Riddle University in aeronautical science with a specialty in aviation safety.



In 1996, McArthur was commissioned from the University of Utah Reserve Officers Training Corps program as a U.S. Air Force 2nd Lt. He served in five different major commands and served as a three time commander while serving in several senior leadership roles. He supported 13 different mission design series aircraft as an aircraft maintenance officer, acquisition specialist, program manager and staff officer. He deployed in support of Operations Northern Watch and Iraqi Freedom. Furthermore, he retired from the Air Force in 2016 with 20 years of service.

McArthur's military training includes the Aircraft Maintenance Officer Course, Squadron Officer School, Air Command and Staff College, Command General and Staff College of the U.S. Army, and finally Air War College.

Prior to this position, McArthur was the Lockheed Martin Field Team Operations program manager for the Industrial Product Vendor contract. He was responsible for managing all staffing support of three Air Force Logistics Center contracts for Ogden, Utah; Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; and Warner Robins, Georgia worth \$750 million for end-to-end supply chain management of more than 89,000 unique parts filling nearly a quarter million bins.
