## Lt. Col. Corinne F. McClellan

Army Lt. Col. Corinne F. McClellan is a native of Killeen, Texas, and was commissioned into the Army May 5, 2001. She graduated from the Old Dominion University, Norfolk, Virginia, ROTC program with a Bachelor of Science degree in Interdisciplinary Studies. That same year, she graduated from the Chemical Officer Basic Course, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.

McClellan's most recent assignment was with Defense Logistics Agency Troop Support as the chief of Future Operations for J3/5 Operations and Plans directorate. During her tenure at DLA Troop Support, she deployed to the Kingdom of Jordan as the Defense Logistics Agency liaison officer in support of Operations Inherent Resolve, Deliberate Resolve and Freedom's Sentinel.



Her previous assignments McClellan served as the regimental chemical officer with the 2-1 Aviation Regiment, 1st Infantry Division in Katterback, Germany, which deployed to Kosovo in 2002. During this deployment, she served as a battle captain in support of Task Force Falcon. In 2003, she transitioned to the Transportation Corps and was assigned to the 180th Transportation Battalion, 3rd Corps Support Command in Manheim, Germany. She then deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom as a platoon leader for the 515th Transportation Company.

In 2005, the 180th Transportation Battalion again deployed to OIF where McClellan served as the battalion S2. In 2008, she attended the Combined Captain's Career Course at Fort Lee, Virginia. She was then assigned to Fort Hood, Texas, and activated the 154th Transportation Company, 181st Transportation Battalion, 13th Expeditionary Sustainment Command. In 2009, she deployed the 154th Transportation Company to Operation Iraqi Freedom. Four months later, McClellan deployed her company from Iraq to Afghanistan when the unit was re-missioned in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. Upon re-deployment, she transitioned as the motor rail officer for the 4th Sustainment Brigade, 13th Expeditionary Sustainment Command. In 2011, she served as the executive officer to the U.S. Army Central G4-Forward and commanding general Army Materiel Command Southwest Asia at Camp Arifjan, Kuwait. Upon her redeployment to Shaw Air Force Base, South Carolina, she served as the G4 mobility operations planner.

In 2013, McClellan graduated from the Command and General Staff College at Ft Belvoir, Virginia. She then served as the support operations officer for 3d Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division in Fort Bliss, Texas. In 2014, she was assigned to 833d Transportation Battalion, 597th Transportation Brigade, Surface Deployment and Distribution Commands where she served as the battalion operation's officer and then commander of the 689th Rapid Port Opening Element. During this assignment, she completed her Master of Arts in Procurement and Acquisition Management from Webster University, Missouri.
