Navy Cmdr. Marcus M. Craig is a native of Muskogee, Oklahoma. He is a graduate of Muskogee High School and the Naval Academy Preparatory School. He received his commission from the U.S. Naval Academy in 2004 and holds a Master of Business Administration with a concentration in Petroleum Management from the University of Kansas School of Business.

Craig was most recently assigned to the Future Operations Directorate in U.S. Africa Command, serving as the Joint Logistics Operational Center chief, providing full spectrum logistics support to maintain operations and key strategic partnerships within the AFRICOM area of responsibility.



Operationally, Craig served onboard the USS Cape St. George (CG 71) as the supply officer. He also served onboard the USS Johnn C. Stennis (CVN 74) as the aviation support division repairable management branch officer, aviation support division officer, and the ship's sales officer. During his tours, Craig participated in Operation Enduring Freedom, Rim of the Pacific Exercise and conducted independent 7th Fleet Maritime Presence.

Ashore, Craig served as the assistant to the director of supply corps detailing at the Office of Supply Corps Personnel (PERS-4412) in Millington, Tennessee and as the aviation support equipment integrated weapons system team director (N9822) at Naval Supply Systems Command Weapon Systems Support Philadelphia. He also was assigned to NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Site Diego Garcia where he served as the fuels officer for bulk fuel products under the Base Operating Service Contract on Naval Support Facility Diego Garcia. Additionally, Craig served as force supply continuous process improvement officer, the assistant Naval Air Station Officer for Policy and Inspections, and the facilities manager at Commander Naval Air Forces Pacific. While assigned to the University of Kansas, Craig worked as a supply chain analyst intern at the Hawker Beechcraft Corporation's Logistics Center.

Craig is a qualified Surface Warfare Supply Corps officer and Naval Aviation Supply officer and has earned Level 3 Life Cycle Logistics and Acquisition Professional Membership. Additionally, he has earned the Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal with three oak leaf clusters and the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal along with various other unit and personal awards.
