Dennis B. Goodnight became Deputy Director of DLA Distribution Oklahoma City, Oklahoma in November 2016.

A native of Oklahoma, Goodnight began his career in the United States Army in 1980, retiring in 2001. He served in numerous Infantry Leadership positions, including a combat tour with the 101st Airborne Division in Desert Storm. Other assignments include Army Aviation, Army Recruiting Command and Civil Affairs/Psychological operations. Goodnight holds a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from the University of Phoenix and a Master of Science in Public Administration from the University of Oklahoma.

At the conclusion of his Army career, he began his current career with DLA Distribution Oklahoma City where he was assigned as a Woodworker. During this period, he was chosen to write the Government's bid for Depot Operations in the OMR Circular A-76 Public Private competition, where he remained until DLA Distribution Oklahoma City was designated as a Strategic Distribution Platform. In 2005, he was selected as Deputy Operations Division Chief where he planned and assisted HQ DLA Distribution implement BRAC at Tinker AFB. In 2006, Goodnight stood up and Managed the Performance Excellence Office as well as forming the genesis of the VPP program office at DDOO. In 2007, he was selected to manage the Support Services Division where he served until his present assignment as Deputy Director.

Goodnight's military education includes the US Army Basic, Advanced and Senior Non Commissioned Officers Schools, Army Recruiting School, Platform Instructor's School and Operations and Intelligence School.
