Navy Cmdr. Timothy J. Calvo, a native of Guam, graduated from the University of Portland, Oregon, in 2001 with a Bachelor of Science in Life Science. He received his commission via Officer Candidate School in 2002. He holds a Master of Business Administration in Financial Management from the Naval Postgraduate School.

His operational assignments include tours on USNS San Jose as the material/stock control officer and supply officer on USS Alaska.

Previous ashore assignments include material operations officer at Naval Medical Center San Diego, California; deputy business financial manager for the Navy and Marine Corps' Multi-Mission Tactical Unmanned Air System; comptroller for Commander, Submarine Force U.S. Pacific Fleet and served on the staff of the Director, Warfare Integration.

His joint individual augmentation assignments include serving as deputy logistics officer for the U.S. Security Coordinator for Israel and the Palestinian Authority and as the director for Resources to Commander, Combined Joint Task Force – Horn of Africa in Djibouti.
