Ben Harvey assumed the position as the DLA Distribution Richmond, Virginia, deputy director on Oct. 31, 2016.

A native of Signal Mountain, Tennessee, Harvey graduated from the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga in 1986 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science and was commissioned as an Army second lieutenant.

His first assignment was as a tank platoon leader in 24th Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, Georgia. He has served in a variety of positions including tank company executive officer in 24th Infantry Division, range safety officer at the Wildflecken Training Area, tank company commander in 3rd Infantry Division, cavalry squadron S4 in 5-17 Cavalry, cavalry headquarters troop commander in 2d Armored Cavalry Regiment, J3 planner in Joint Task Force Civil Support, S3 of the Special Troops Battalion in the 167th TSC, support operations section in 13th ESC, J5 future plans officer and J9 director at DLA Distribution headquarters, and strategic planner at the Army Materiel Command.

Harvey's assignments include Fort Knox, Kentucky; Fort Stewart, Georgia; Wildflecken, Germany; Schweinfurt, Germany; Fort Liberty, North Carolina; Camp Pelham, South Korea; Fort Johnson, Louisiana; Birmingham, Alabama; Fort Monroe, Virginia; Fort Cavazos, Texas; New Cumberland, Pennsylvania; and Redstone Arsenal, Alabama. Harvey completed tours in Operation Desert Shield, Operation Desert Storm, and Operation Iraqi Freedom.
