Bradley D. Kearney assumed the position of deputy commander, Defense Logistics Agency Distribution Tobyhanna, Pennsylvania, November 4, 2024. As deputy commander, Kearney directs all facets of daily operations of a strategic joint distribution center with a military and civilian workforce responsible for providing logistics support to all services.

Prior to his position at DDTP, Kearney worked as the Safety/Security specialist at DLA Distribution Tobyhanna, Pennsylvania. Kearney also worked as a Supervisor in Retail Operations at DLA Distribution Tobyhanna.



Kearney concluded his distinguished Army career in 2018, retiring as a Chief Warrant Officer 3. His service commenced as an Infantry Soldier with the 25th Infantry Division at Ft. Lewis, Washington, and later with the 4th Infantry Division at Ft. Wainwright, Alaska where he held various leadership positions.

Throughout his tenure, Kearney excelled as a senior logistics manager, overseeing the operations of a forward-deployed medical logistics site. In 2006, he advanced his career by attending the Army Warrant Officer Candidate course, subsequently commissioning as a Warrant officer in the U.S. Army Aviation Corps.

Kearney's exemplary service included multiple combat tours in support of the Global War on Terrorism in both Iraq and Afghanistan. His expertise led to his selection for the Army Warrant Officer advanced course and the Instructor Pilot course. He ultimately served as a senior standardization officer with the 10th Combat Aviation

His commendations are numerous including, the Army Meritorious Service Medal, Air Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Army Achievement Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Humanitarian Service Medal, Army Aviation Badge, Combat Action Badge, Expert Field Medical Badge, and the Air Assault Badge.
