



DLA Distribution Tobyhanna, Pa. Mr. Raymond Martin Deputy Commander

Raymond L. Martin assumed the position of deputy commander, Defense Logistics Agency Distribution Tobyhanna, Pennsylvania, April 26, 2020. As deputy commander, Martin directs all facets of daily operations of a strategic joint distribution center with a military and civilian workforce responsible for providing logistics support to all services.

Prior to his position at DDTP, Martin worked as the division chief, Support Services, at DLA Distribution Susquehanna, Pennsylvania. Martin also served as deputy commander at DLA Distribution Puget Sound, Washington, from 2011-2017. Martin served as the deputy commander for DLA Distribution Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, from October 2010 to October 2011.

Prior to entering service with DLA in 2010, Martin served as deputy commander/logistics manager of the 18th Logistics Readiness Squadron, Kadena Air Base, Japan. In this capacity, he directed operations of the largest logistics readiness squadrons in the Air Force, composed of 761 military, civilian, and local national personnel providing deployment, distribution, fuels, materiel, and vehicle management support to all four military services on the island of Okinawa, Japan.

Martin has been in Defense Department logistics for more than 32 years, performing in positions in Air Force base-level operations, Headquarters Air Combat Command Logistics Division, Headquarters Air Mobility Command, and the Air Force Global Logistics Support Center.

Martin has a bachelor of science degree in management information systems from Minot State University where he graduated magna cum laude, and was selected as the "Number One" Management Information Systems student of his 2002 graduating class.
