Natalie Lee-Haynes assumed the role of deputy director for DLA Distribution Warner Robins, Georgia, on June 1, 2026.

Lee-Haynes brings 17 years of comprehensive logistics, distribution, and organizational leadership experience within DLA Distribution. She began her federal career in 2008 as a Material Handler at AAFES Sharpe Depot in Lathrop, California, quickly progressing into DLA as a Distribution Process Worker. Throughout her career, she has excelled in roles of increasing responsibility across warehousing, security controlled operations, audit compliance, and major enterprise projects. Her early experience building operational expertise and leading teams in high visibility environments set the foundation for her advancement into supervisory and senior management roles.



She has served as a first line supervisor in Bulk Receiving; a GS 11 Quality Assurance Evaluator supporting successful Ernst & Young audits; and Branch Chief of Central Receiving, where she leveraged her compliance background to improve audit readiness and operational performance. Her leadership has extended across multiple strategic initiatives, including the Ft. Carson Proof of Principle, Navy Stock In Transit, USS Emory Offload, Class IV Border Support, and the Brad Bunn Leadership Competency Effort.

In 2019, Lee-Haynes became Deputy Division Chief of the Bin Division, supporting cross functional operations in Mech Storage, Mech Packing, and FMS. She prioritized leadership development, operational innovation, and the integration of Voice Pick technologies. She later served as Chief of the Special Commodities F 35 Division, overseeing the North American Regional Wholesale site responsible for global F 35 distribution operations in collaboration with the Joint Program Office, Lockheed Martin, and Department of Veterans Affairs partners.

She has been recognized with multiple awards for leadership and performance, including DLA Global Excellence Civilian Leader of the Year (2020), the DLA Global Excellence High Performing Leader of the Year (2021), and several Team of the Quarter awards. Her consistent record of results underscores her ability to lead high impact operations, strengthen organizational culture, and drive mission success.

Prior to this assignment she served as the Mission Group Deputy Chief for Defense Logistics Agency Distribution San Joaquin, located in Tracy, California, the Department of Defense's Western Strategic Distribution Platform. In this role, she provided senior leadership, strategic planning, and operational oversight for fourteen warehouses and outside storage areas, leading a diverse workforce of more than 350 employees. Her group executed over 1.2 million customer orders annually in support of joint, interagency, and international partners.
