Ms. Melinda Stahl assumed the role as the deputy director at Defense Logistics Agency Distribution, Warner Robins, Georgia, on Sept. 27, 2020. Before this position, Stahl has held numerous positions within DLA Aviation and DLA Distribution.

From 2017-2020, Stahl served as a material management section chief for DLA Aviation at Warner Robins overseeing the retail material support for both the Aircraft Maintenance Group and the Electronics Maintenance Group. During her time supporting Aircraft Maintenance she led a team of approximately 40 individuals overseeing the management of over \$74 million worth of parts. During her time supporting the Electronics Maintenance Group she led a team of over 50 individuals all working to manage over \$50 million worth of inventory supporting the Air Force maintenance customers.

From 2011-2017, Stahl worked for DLA Aviation at Warner Robins supporting the Commodities Maintenance Group. She worked to support various components and major end item repairs needed to support C-17, C-130, C-5 and F-15 Aircraft. She also oversaw the supportability of raw materials needed to manufacture and repair a wide array of aircraft components.

From 2008-2011 Stahl worked for DLA Distribution at Warner Robins in many different capacities. Her experience at DLA Distribution ranges from being a member of the newly formed (at the time) Inventory Action Team, being a member of the Emergency Supply Operations team, and a systems analyst. As a systems analyst she was designated as the receiving training Lead. She took lead on many projects and worked closely with other DLA organizations to implement process and system changes when needed.

Stahl is a native of Warner Robins, Georgia, and a graduate of Warner Robins High School. She attended the University of Georgia. She is also Level III certified in Life Cycle Logistics. She has received numerous awards and most notably the DLA Director's Strategic Goals Certificate twice.
