Navy Cmdr. Long Tran is a native of Houston, Texas. He earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Houston before receiving his commission through Officer Candidate School in 2009. He holds a Master of Business Administration in supply chain management from the Naval Postgraduate School.

He assumed command of Defense Logistics Agency Distribution Yokosuka, Japan, in June 2026.

His operational assignments include tours as the assistant supply officer onboard the USS Hopper, a guided missile destroyer; supply officer onboard the USS Leyte Gulf, a guided missile cruiser; and assistant supply officer, principal assistant for logistics and principal assistant for services onboard the USS Ronald Reagan, a nuclear-powered aircraft carrier.

His shore duty assignments include contract specialist for Defense Logistics Agency Troop Support in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; director of regional services for the Naval Supply Systems Command Fleet Logistics Center Yokosuka in Yokosuka, Japan; and supply corps career counselor and pit boss / lieutenant commander detailee for the Supply Corps Office of Personnel at Navy Personnel Command in Millington, Tennessee.
