Bernard Domingo became Deputy Commander at DLA Distribution Yokosuka, Japan, in August 2023. He was previously Deputy Commander at DLA Distribution Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. From 2015 to 2023, Domingo served various leadership positions at DDPH as Retail Operations Chief, Accountable Officer, and Wholesale Operations Chief. Also, during this time he was selected to fill key billets as DLA Distribution Liaison Officer to DLA Headquarters Agency Synchronization and Operations Center in Fort Belvoir, Virginia, from September 2020 to February 2021 and interim Deputy Commander at DLA Distribution Yokosuka, Japan, from September to December 2022. He previously served as AO at DDYJ from 2011 to 2015.

Domingo worked in Japan for DLA Disposition Services from 2008 to 2011 in Okinawa as a controlled property center researcher, in Yokosuka as a disposal service representative, in Sagami as the environmental chief, in Misawa as a temporary site director, and deployed for six months to Camp Speicher, Iraq, as part of the Civilian Expeditionary Workforce. Domingo was a Navy Supply Corps Officer and served onboard USS PONCE (LPD 15) in Norfolk, VA; Supply Officer, Marine Corps Air Station Futenma, Okinawa, Japan; and Supply Officer onboard USS VANDEGRIFT (FFG 48) in Yokosuka, Japan.

Domingo graduated from the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland, in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science in Weapons and Systems Engineering. He has a Master of Arts in Management, completed advance courses in Economics, completed the LOGTECH Executive Development Program at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, was an adjunct professor for leadership and management, and is a certified Lean Six Sigma Green Belt. He is currently pursuing a Doctor of Management in organizational leadership.

During his military and civilian careers, Domingo has received several organizational and team awards including four DLA strategic goals team awards, two annual Global Distribution Excellence team awards, two Joint Meritorious Unit awards, and others. Individual awards include two Meritorious Civilian Service awards, three Superior Civilian Service awards, Global War on Terror Medal, Humanitarian Service award, qualified as a Surface Warfare Supply Corps Officer, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation medal, two Navy/Marine Corps Achievement medals, and others.
