# **Joint Petroleum Week**

More than 300 petroleum leaders, including representatives from combatant commands and service control point partners, attended Joint Petroleum Week held in the McNamara Headquarters Complex at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, Feb. 26 to March 1.

DLA Energy hosted the week-long event that brings together senior non-commissioned officers, warrant officers, mid-grade officers and civilian equivalents from across the community and exposes them to high-level briefings, discussions and system demonstrations designed to expand their knowledge in the joint petroleum arena.

"I am confident that the people we need to solve problems are here in this room," said DLA Energy Commander Navy Capt. Brian Anderson during his opening remarks.
