New DFSP at the North Pole

DLA Energy Americas held a ribbon cutting ceremony for the new DFSP North Pole on July 26.

No, not a place to fuel up the back up engine for Santa's sleigh in the Arctic Circle, but a DFSP in the city of North Pole, Alaska, located about 11 miles north of Eielson Air Force Base and 14 miles south of Fairbanks.

Keynote speaker for the ceremony was the newly returning DLA Americas Commander Army COL Josiel Carrasquillo. *Welcome back to the Energy family, Ma'am!* Alongside her was the DLA Energy Americas North Commander Air Force Maj Barton Land.

DFSP North Pole begins its journey as crude oil at the North Slope and travels 800 miles through the Trans-Alaska Pipeline to multiple refineries. Ships, barges, rail, and trucks carry the fuels to their destinations. Weather, natural disasters and geographical roadblocks challenge the mission every day.

The North Pole facility was completed five months ahead of schedule and is strategically located to provide support to Eielson AFB with direct pipeline support and has the capability to support Fort Wainwright and Fort Greely by truck if required.

The construction of a contractor-owned, contractor-operated fuel storage facility was chosen as the best option to move forward to address the fuel storage deficiency, Land said.

In her remarks, Carrasquillo thanked Land and his team for their great work providing quality fuel solutions to the Warfighters of the North.

"We are the bulk petroleum logistics fuel experts and part of our Artic Warriors," Carrasquillo said. "To the DLA Energy Americas North Team, I leave you with this charge; to keep up your phenomenal work and to always remember the 'why' of what we do: to serve the Warfighter and our Nation."



DLA Energy East Pacific and Americas West teams have been busy providing bulk fuel support to Rim of the Pacific 2022 in and around the Hawaiian Islands and Southern California, June 29 to Aug. 4. During the exercise, 26 nations, 38 surface ships, four submarines, nine national land forces, more than 30 unmanned systems, approximately 170 aircraft and more than 25,000 personnel will train and operate together.

The world's largest international maritime exercise, RIMPAC helps foster and sustain cooperative relationships among participants critical to ensuring the safety of sea lanes and security on the world's oceans.

RIMPAC 2022 is the 28th in the series that began in 1971.
