It's great to be back home after an 18-day INDOPACOM battlefield circulation trip! This was my first opportunity to visit our furthest Pacific regional commands and see firsthand the great efforts our folks are providing for warfighter/ customer support in the region. Stops included Hawaii, Yokota AB, Iwakuni MCAS, Okinawa, Camp Henry, Camp Humphreys, and Singapore.

At each stop during our trip, the theme emerged and remained consistent—we have incredible teammates all around the world that make the impossible look easy. Our team in Hawaii continues to be a vital part of Joint Task Force – Red Hill. In Japan, our teammates manage a complex supply chain for the warfighter, while supporting families by purchasing fuel for AAFES. One of our most unique DFSPs exists at Okinawa. DLA Energy owns and operates the site together with over 100 local nationals. In Korea, our team is ready to "Fight Tonight," given the proximity to bad actors in the region. Our QARs in Singapore demonstrate what it means to be "small but mighty," handling a big mission with few resources.

One of my highlights was a boat tour in Okinawa to see the single and multi-point mooring systems that facilitate bulk fuel transfer. We experienced some pretty heavy wind and rain, but thankfully no lightning within 5 miles! Another highlight was a staff ride to the DMZ, which remains a stark reminder of a forgotten war—and perhaps a bigger reminder of a ROK-US alliance that must remain strong to deter enemy action from the north.

Last week was amazing as we brought back Joint Petroleum week in full force! It was a busy agenda, but we made great progress during the sessions and networking events.

As always, I am proud of our workforce's continued support across the globe and see the hard work and efforts being performed. I am ever-humbled to serve with you all!

21st Annual Joint Petroleum Seminar

The Joint Petroleum Seminar returned to the McNamara Headquarters Complex at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, Feb. 6-7.

DLA Energy hosted the annual two-day unclassified event that brought together more than 191 petroleum leaders, including representatives from combatant commands and service control point partners. Senior noncommissioned officers, warrant officers, mid-grade officers and civilian equivalents from across the community were provided high-level briefings, panel discussions and system demonstrations designed to expand their knowledge in the joint petroleum arena.



The seminar's timing coincided with U.S. Transportation Command becoming the "element responsible for bulk fuel management and delivery of the Department of Defense on global basis," per the 2022 National Defense Authorization Act.

The forum provided an opportunity for TRANSCOM to continue socializing their new role as single manager with the broader DLA Energy team, Combatant Command Joint Petroleum Offices, and Service Control Point representatives. In this role, TRANSCOM will synchronize the bulk fuel posture, planning, and execution, and advocate for resources, capabilities, and process improvements in coordination with Combatant Commands, the Services, and DLA.



During the Joint Petroleum Seminar, DLA Energy Americas Commander COL Carrasquillo presented Jason Hill the Joint Civilian Service Achievement Award. Jason was recognized for his service as the DLA Energy LNO to SOUTHCOM from Oct. 15-Nov. 15, 2022 during Operation Fueled Commitment where he supported the fuel requirements for the U.S. Embassy in Haiti and the U.S. Agency for International Development.
