1. Fence Prevents infants from straying out of the playground.														
2. Area is securely fenced, gate latches are locked and may be opened only by adults.														
3. Play equipment surfaces (platforms, stairs, rugs) are smooth, splinter-free, and free of slippery materials, such as water, ice, sand, or leaves.														
4. The amount of cushioning material under climbers, slides, and swings is adequate (free of low areas or holes).														
5. There are no sharp edges, pinch points, protruding or rusty objects, missing parts, or hot surfaces.														
6. There are no sharp objects, holes, broken glass, feces, foreign objects, debris or standing water.														
7. Play area is free of trash and trash receptacles and surrounding areas are free of spills.														
8. No frayed cable, worn ropes or chains that could pinch.														
9. Sand boxes are covered when not in use and raked daily.														
10. Screws, nuts, and bolts on equipment are securely fastened, free of rust, and recessed.
