The first product I was asked to contribute to the deployment standard operating procedures (SOP) was a list of supplies my team needed to be successful while deployed. The first time I was asked this, I had no idea what to bring. I had not been told about the Chaplain's Kit, consumables or what a National Stock Number (NSN) was. But this is not the case anymore; https://www.dla.mil/Chaplain is a one-stop shop for everything you need to build out your deployment kit with government-approved items that do not require bids and support federal programs that promote sustainability, small- and female-owned businesses, and Historically Underutilized Business Zone that bring jobs to areas with high unemployment. We have a customer support team dedicated to sustaining ecclesiastical supplies.

Upcoming Religious Holidays and DLA Solutions

DLA provides the highest quality items at the best price while meeting all federal regulations. To be good stewards of taxpayer money, DLA works with United States Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM) to find the best way to ship supplies around the world. Perishable items like the Four Species and Palm Leaves shipments are expedited, but other items are shipped with standard priority. Standard shipping for most items is 30 days for CONUS, 90 days for OCONUS. Consider funding cycles in your planning for purchasing upcoming holiday items. See below for some recommendations:
