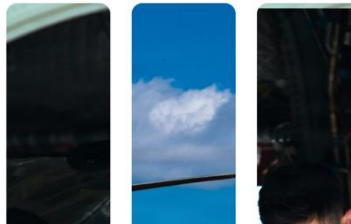

Getting Started

As a supplier, partnering with the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) gives the opportunity to directly support the mission of the U.S. Department of Defense by delivering essential goods and services to our nation's warfighters.



Key Things to Know:

- 1 Verify if DLA Buys What You Sell:** Determine if your products or services align with DLA's needs by reviewing what we purchase and finding relevant DLA buying organizations. Familiarize yourself with the DLA's mission and processes by reviewing the [DLA Overview for Vendor](#).

Through the Web-Quoting System (WQS), suppliers can submit quotes, access procurement opportunities, and track bids. By partnering with DLA, suppliers strengthen the defense supply chain and help ensure our military has the resources needed to protect the nation.

An approved AMPS registration/role is mandatory for authenticated access into DLA Supplier Portal which will allow access to DLA Web-Quoting. This document provides step-by-step guidance on requesting the necessary role.

- 2 Get Help & Support:** For assistance with your registration process, connect with your local [APEX Accelerators](#).
- 3 Register Your Company:** Set up your company on [System for Award Management \(SAM.gov\)](#) to obtain a Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code. Once your CAGE code is active, proceed to register in the DLA Supplier Portal.
- 4 Engage in the Contracting Process:** Actively review solicitations, prepare and submit competitive bids, and manage any awarded contracts.
- 5 Fulfill Contract Obligations:** Fulfill your contracts by delivering products or services as specified, maintain communication with your Contract Administrator, and submitting invoices to [Defense Finance and Accounting Service \(DFAS\)](#) for payment.

Quick start guides for Entity Registration?

After you submit your entity registration, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) validates your taxpayer information. Then, the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) validates your legal business name, physical address, and other information to assign a Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code if applicable. The average time to process these validations is 10 to 15 business days. Once DLA has reviewed the registration, the person listed as the Government Business Point of Contact on your registration receives email updates.


Common Reasons DLA Rejects a Registration:

- According to Secretary of State records or other state filings, the legal business name does not match exactly.
- The physical address is a virtual office.
 - DLA requires the physical address to be complete, including suite or office numbers.
- The Secretary of State office has deemed the organization dissolved or out of business with the Secretary of State.
- The Government Business Point of Contact did not respond to emails from DLA requesting additional information within three business days.
- A duplicate Unique Entity ID exists for the same entity.

How to Fix a Rejected Entity Registration?

You can update an entity registration once it is returned to the Work in Progress status. If the status still shows as submitted, you must wait until DLA returns the registration to the Work in Progress status.

Correcting Your Information

- Contact DLA for questions on specific rejection reasons.
- Confirm with your Secretary of State office that your entity information is up to date and matches the registration.
- Ensure the address provided is a physical address. Post office boxes and virtual addresses are not accepted.
- Be sure the Government Business Point of Contact is replying to emails if DLA requests more information. DLA email addresses end in dla.mil.
- If you have a duplicate Unique Entity ID, determine which one you need, and contact the Federal Service Desk for assistance deleting the duplicate from the system.

New Supplier Pathway program links small businesses to DLA supply chains

January 16th, 2025



Small business owners interested in contracting with the Defense Logistics Agency can now use a new search function on [DLA's Small Business webpage](#) to get contact information for the supply chain that manages the items or services they provide. The new tool is the first iteration of a more extensive Supplier Pathway program intended to help new entrants navigate government contracting processes and learn the nuances of working with DLA.

Arming small businesses with the information they need to create pathways for contracting with us is just one way we're working to expand our industrial base partnerships" - DLA Vice Director Brad Bunn.

"Stronger ties with small businesses will ultimately strengthen our industrial base and lead us to solutions for tough challenges like logistics in a contested environment."

Users only need to enter the supply or service they wish to provide, then hit "search" to get results that include a product or service code and the name of the DLA supply chain that manages the item or service. Links to specific supply chains are

included on the page to give prospective vendors information ranging from explanations of procurement processes to policies and procedures relevant to doing business with the agency.

New suppliers are often unaware that DLA has multiple supply chains or that goods and services are arranged by codes to help facilitate management, said DLA Small Business Director Daniele Kurze.

"Many businesses who have not contracted with us before do not know what a [national stock number](#) or federal supply class is, and government jargon can be confusing," Kurze added. "We want to make it easier for new entrants to see where they fit into our supply chains, then help them connect with DLA small business specialists and program managers focused on their areas."

While the initial stage of the Supplier Pathway program gives small businesses an entry point, the next will outline steps they must take to partner with the agency.

"We want suppliers to clearly understand the steps they need to take in their particular pathway to be successful. We will provide a roadmap of certifications they'll need and associated timelines for how long it might take," Kurze said.

Kurze's team will roll out enhancements to Supplier Pathways through fiscal 2025. Debuting iterations incrementally will help small businesses benefit from the tool as the agency continues shaping it over time, she said.

"We also welcome ideas from industry on things they'd like the tool to do," Kurze added.

Supplier Pathways targets new entrants but can also help current suppliers or service providers considering expanding their business. It also allows vendors to get helpful information on their own 24/7 rather than having to wait until business hours to call a DLA office.

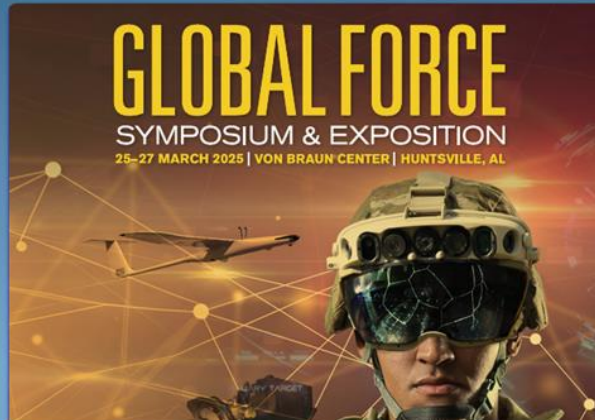
