

Hazardous Information Resource System (HMIRS) Fact Sheet

What is HMIRS?

HMIRS is the DOD repository for Safety Data Sheets (SDS) and related information on hazardous materials and currently contains over 700,000 product records. HMIRS is available online at https://dlahng.hmms.dla.mil/HMMS_Web_JSF/index.xhtml.

Why HMIRS?

[DoDI 6050 DoD Hazard Communication \(HAZCOM\) Program](#) provides instruction for government agencies to maintain information on all products containing hazardous materials. DoDI 6050 establishes policy, assigns responsibility, and provides procedures for the DoD HAZCOM Program. It implements regulatory requirements Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 29, Parts 1910.120, 1910.1200, 1910.1450, 1915.1200, and 1926.59, and applies to all organizational entities within DoD. HMIRS fulfills the DoD's responsibility under DoDI 6050 appointing DLA as the lead Component and Administrator for Enterprise data management.

Applying for Access

Access to HMIRS is controlled by the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) through the use of the Account Management and Provisioning System (AMPS). Requests for access to HMIRS must be made online using the AMPS website at <https://amps.dla.mil>. Once registered, access control at DLA will provide a User ID and Password which can be used for initial access to HMIRS, after the initial access, your CAC will be used for future access.
