DLA provides the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) with an Account Management and Provisioning System to control, track, and route for approval and action, requests for access to DFAS networks, computer systems, and databases.

Personal Information collected is: Name, Citizenship Status (i.e., "U.S.," "Foreign National," or "Other"), and if "U.S." is selected under Citizenship Status, then either DoD ID Number (EDIPI) or Social Security Number (SSN)—if the individual is not in possession of a Common Access Card (CAG):

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

The risk associated with this collection is the same as those for other systems collecting Social Security Number (SSN) -- being used for other than "For Official Use Only" purposes. This has been minimized through encryption and only displaying SSN in plain text to DFAS security officer(s) assigned to manage the specific request. The security office role/access in AMPS is only granted to individuals that hold a security officer position. All DFAS employees, under the requirements of the DoD Privacy Program, are made aware of the restrictions on secondary uses of the data records by initial and refresher Information Assurance and Privacy training. Security risks associated with maintaining data in an electronic environment have been mitigated through administrative, technical, and physical safeguards. The safeguards are commensurate with the risk and magnitude of harm that could result from the loss, misuse, or unauthorized access to or modification of the data.
