RIR and HHRA Newspaper Notification

Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) has prepared a Remedial Investigation Report (RIR) and Human Health Risk Assessment (HHRA) for the former Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (DSCP) in accordance with Pennsylvania's Land Recycling and Environmental Standards Act (Act 2) Program. The site is a former Department of Defense property closed under the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Commission. The former DSCP, now commonly referred to as Quartermaster Plaza, is located at 2800 South 20th Street, Philadelphia, PA. The RIR and HHRA collectively describe the nature and extent of groundwater contamination, summarize remediation efforts to date, and provide information on future efforts to achieve closure under the Act 2 Program and address human health risk.

DLA invites you to attend a public meeting where Seres Arcadis, whom DLA contracted to handle the remediation, will provide a summary of the ongoing remediation actions and planned path to achieve closure. The public meeting will be virtual and is scheduled for April 29, 2026, 6:00-8:00 PM and will discuss comments received on the RIR and HHRA.
