Newspaper Notification for Public Comment Period and Public Meeting on Proposed Plans

Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) has prepared two Proposed Plans summarizing environmental activities for “Action Sites” and “Land Use Control (LUC) Sites” at the Former Curtis Bay Ordnance Depot (Depot) located at 710 East Ordnance Road in Anne Arundel County, Maryland. Cleanup activities are being conducted in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), as amended, 42 U.S. Code § 9617(a), and the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) at 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 300.430(f)(2).
