



## **DLA Installation Support**

### **Marvin Wenberg Deputy Director, DLA Installation Support**



Marvin Wenberg serves as the Deputy Director, DLA Installation Support, providing Enterprise-wide agency policy, program, and world-wide operational support in Environmental Management, Safety and Occupational Health; Property, Plant and Equipment; Installation Management; Security and Emergency Services; Family Morale Welfare and Recreation (FMWR), and Business Management. DLA Installation Support directs administration of corporate policy for centralized management and support service functions of the Agency.

Marv Wenberg started his DoD career at the Navy Supply Corps School after being commissioned an Ensign, USNR, and then completed Submarine School. He then became the Supply Officer of the submarine USS DANIEL BOONE (SSBN 629) Blue Crew. Selected assignments include: Assistant Fuel Director, Naval Supply Center Pearl Harbor; Director, Fuel Department serving concurrently as Director, Material Turned-Into-Store, Naval Supply Center, Charleston, SC; and then as Readiness and Services Officer, USS ENTERPRISE (CVN 65). Originally assigned to the Defense Fuel Supply Center as the Assistant Chief, Special Acquisitions Division, Mr. Wenberg moved up to the position of Chief, Plans, Policy and Systems Office (Acquisitions) and then became the Executive Officer and served 9 months during DESERT SHIELD and DESERT STORM as the DESC senior officer in charge of the Emergency Supply Operations Center. Afterwards, he became the Deputy Program Manager (Business and Operations), V-22 Tilt-rotor Aircraft Program Office (NAVAIR) and then the Supply Officer, USS SAIPAN (LHA 2).

In May 1998, then Captain Wenberg, SC, USN reported to the United States Strategic Command (STRATCOM) assuming duties as the senior logistician with concurrent responsibility for nuclear weapons surety oversight. He then assumed duties as Commanding Officer of the Naval Petroleum Office (Navy Supply Systems Command Energy). In August 2003, Captain Wenberg assumed the duties of the Deputy Director of the Defense Energy Support Center, (DLA Energy) until his retirement in early 2007. While on active duty, he was authorized to wear the Naval Aviation Supply Officer and the Submarine Breast Insignias. He was designated a Joint Services Officer in DoD with numerous high level awards and is certified DAWIA Level III (contracting).

Mr. Wenberg graduated from Purdue University with a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry and is a graduate of the Navy's Petroleum, Oil and Lubricant Intern Program and the Armed Forces Staff College. He received a MS degree in Petroleum Management from both Science (Petroleum Engineering) and Business Schools, University of Kansas and a MS in Acquisition and Contract Management from the Florida Institute of Technology. Marv Wenberg is a graduate of the University of Michigan Winter 2000 Executive Training Program.

In June 2007, Mr. Wenberg joined the DLA in a civilian capacity as the Site Director, DS Energy followed by Staff Director, Installation Management, DLA Installation Support prior to his recent assignment. Mr. Wenberg is married and has 6 daughters.
