## Federal Logistics (FED LOG®) Data



The Federal Logistics Information System (FLIS) forms the foundation for all DOD logistics information systems. It is the cataloging database of more than 16 million Items of Supply used by the United States Government (USG), North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), and Partner Nations. The **Federal Logistics (FED LOG®)** data provides the ability to access and download FLIS data for use when Internet connectivity is not available. FED LOG® provides essential information about materiel that includes the NSN, Item Name, Design Control Activity, Manufacturers' and Suppliers' information (CAGE & Part Numbers), Freight Data, Packaging Data, Hazardous Materiel Indicators, Interchangeable and Substitutable data, Acquisition Advice Code (AAC) and Unit Price, Physical and / or Performance Characteristics along with service specific management data.

FED LOG® is available as a free downloadable product using [FedMail](#) and is available in 'Complete' or 'Lite' versions. The lite version is about half the size of the complete version, so it downloads quicker. FED LOG® is published monthly and is a product which is restricted Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) and available to NATO and NATO Sponsored Countries, Federal and Civilian Agencies, Government contractors and DOD.

### FED LOG® Queries:

FED LOG® offers two powerful search options to maximize logistics data research capabilities:

- **Interactive Search:** FLIS, Characteristics, CAGE, Army, Marines, Support Equipment, H2, H3, H6, History and SQL Tabs
- **Search Batch:** process multiple NSNs or Part Numbers queries and specify specific Data Elements pull and produce reports in a spreadsheet format

Internal Research Links:

Links within FED LOG® allow the users with internet access the ability to access WebFLIS® for real time data, FedMail for procurement options, ASSIST which provides DOD prepared documents (MIL-SPEC/MIL STD) information, MEDALS (access to engineering data asset locator) along with Manufacturer and Suppliers data.

### How can FED LOG® help in your logistics research?

**Typical Scenario: Customer seeks a NSN for a specific pad lock**

**Search FED LOG® with known data**

- Determine the Approved Item Name (AIN): PAD LOCK or PADLOCK
- Search specific criteria: Key\* Alike\* 5 LAM\*
- Screen search results for requirements

Wild Card: Asterisk (\*)

Acceptable styles see Salient Characteristic 2.8

- Search for an item based on key characteristic attributes (what it looks like, what it is made of, and other descriptive information)
- Obtain management data for procurement, requisition, storage, logistical, and management decision usage
- Determine freight standards
- Cross-reference part numbers and stock numbers  
Create batch searches and run large amounts of data
- Customize data to meet specific requirements
- Identify manufactures and distributors
- Obtain service-unique logistic information, for example
  - Army Master Data File (AMDF)
  - Navy Item Control Number (NICN)
  - Marine Corps Master Header Information File (MHIF)
