In accordance with Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Instruction 4715.06, the DLA Installation Management Columbus, Environmental Management Division has developed and implemented an Environmental Management System (EMS). The EMS integrates missions, activities, functions, contracts, and installation support agreements as a business practice for improving overall performance for the Defense Supply Center Columbus (DSCC).

EMS is a vital supporting component of the DoD mission and is therefore the responsibility of all DoD personnel. It requires active participation from all functions and organizations at DSCC. While striving to manage environmental programs through the implementation of an effective EMS we remain committed to:

- a. Complying with all relevant environmental legislation, regulations, and other applicable requirements.
- b. Continual improvement in environmental program performance, measured through the corrective action reports for any internal/ external review findings and environmental initiatives.
- c. Identifying and employing source reduction, sustainable resource use, climate change mitigation and adaptation, ecosystem protection, and pollution prevention opportunities where practicable.
