Civilian Reporting

If a DLA civilian **reports to the DLA SAPR PA**, the SAPR PA can maintain **CONFIDENTIALITY** (with limitations).

If a DLA civilian **reports to a supervisor**, the supervisor is required to notify the SAPR PA if the incident:

- Involves another DLA employee, and/or
- Occurred on federal property (including DLA property)

What is Sexual Assault?

"Sexual assault" is defined as intentional sexual contact, characterized by use of force, threats, intimidation, abuse of authority, or when the victim does not or cannot consent. Sexual assault includes rape, forcible sodomy, and other unwanted indecent contact (e.g., kissing against another person's will) that is aggravated, abusive, or wrongful (to include unwanted and inappropriate sexual

Reporting Options

DoD Restricted Report

(Available to military personnel / adult dependents)

- Confidential
- Access to Military Department (MILDEP) Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC)
- Access to military medical & counseling services*

DoD Unrestricted Report

(Available to all Civilian Personnel)

- Confidential
- Access to DLA SAPR PA or MILDEP SARC, EAP, and Civilian resources

DoD Unrestricted Report

(Available to ALL personnel)

- Sensitive/Need-to-Know
- Access to DLA SAPR PA or MILDEP Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC)
- Access to military medical & counseling services*
- Law enforcement investigation
- Command involvement
