The DLA Contracting Services Office (DCSO) manages DLA enterprise-wide requirements including major information technology (IT) systems and programs, IT products and services, business and facilities services, and other enterprise services for DLA worldwide.

DCSO is also the Department of Defense's provider of <u>document services</u>, including scanning and conversion, printing services, and office device management.

USE OF GSA SCHEDULES & GWACS

Like many other Federal Agencies, DLA often purchases computer hardware, software and professional services using Schedules managed by the General Services Administration (GSA) such as Schedule 70. Schedules, also known as Federal Supply Schedules (FAS), and Multiple Award Schedules (MAS), are long-term governmentwide contracts with commercial companies that provide access to millions of commercial products and services at fair and reasonable prices to the government.

DCSO uses Governmentwide Acquisition Contracts (GWACs) for information technology requirements such as 8(a) STARS III, VETS 2, and Alliant 2 (A2). GWACs are pre-competed, multiple-award, indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contracts that agencies can use to buy total IT solutions.

DCSO also utilizes GSA's OASIS (One Acquisition Solution for Integrated Services) multiple award IDIQ contract vehicle.
