**AMENDMENT NO. 001 (SUPERALLOYS)  
TO  
AUCTION SOLICITATION FOR  
STOCKPILE MATERIALS  
UNDER  
DLA-STOCKPILE MATERIALS-001-(Auction)**

The above referenced solicitation DLA-Stockpile Materials-001-(Auction), issued **May 9, 2025**, is hereby amended to offer recovered superalloys for sale under the Auction Solicitation. This amendment applies to the solicitation only for the offering of recovered superalloys, as follows:

- 1. Section A.6., Inspection (JUN 17)** is amended to add the following for superalloys:

**Section A.6. (Superalloys) Inspection (APR 25)**

- a.** Containers representing all alloy types being offered for sale will be available for inspection. Bidders or their designees are encouraged to visually inspect the material at their expense. Taking physical samples and photographs are not permitted. The inspection will be observed in the presence of and under the direction of a DLA Strategic Materials representative.
- b.** Requests for an appointment to inspect the material must be made by submitting a Material Sample/Inspection Request through the DLA Strategic Materials website at:

All information will be sent by email. The Government reserves the right to limit the number of individuals granted access to the depot or storage location.

- c.** The Bidder, its agents and representatives shall comply at all times with the rules of the storage location.

- 2. Section C.4. Bid Price (APR 25)** is amended to add the following for superalloys:

**Section C.4. Bid Price (Superalloys) (APR 25)**

Bids shall be expressed as a fixed U.S. dollar and cent value, to three decimal places, per pound (lb).

- 3. Section C.5. Price Adjustments for Specific Materials (JUN 17)** does not apply to superalloys and is deleted in its entirety.
- 4. Section C.11. Tie Bid Procedures (APR 25)** is amended to add the following for superalloys:

**Section C.11. Tie Bid Procedures (Superalloys) (APR 25)**

In the event that Bids of an equal unit price are received and there is insufficient quantity of material to satisfy all tied Bids, lots will be drawn to determine the successful Bidder(s) for award of the material.

5. Section E.2. **Storage Charges (APR 25)**, paragraph b., is deleted and revised specifically for superalloys, as follows:

**Section E.2. Storage Charges (Superalloys) (APR 25)**

- b. The storage charge is the greater of the following: (1) **\$0.007 per pound bulk weight** (if a fraction of a pound remains, the charge will be for a full pound) per 30 day period regardless of whether the material remains in storage a period of 30 days or less than 30 days; **or** (2) commercial storage charges, if applicable.
6. Section F.1. **Request for Shipment (APR 25)**, paragraphs a. and g., are deleted and revised specifically for superalloys as follows:

**Section F.1. (Superalloys)**

- a. Delivery of superalloys is F.O.B. carrier's conveyance.
- g. Requests for shipment shall be for a minimum of one entire line item, or if the location balance is less than this quantity, for the balance at the storage location. Shipping instructions and information requested in Section F.1.c., must be submitted as a Shipping Request through the DLA Strategic Materials online sales site.
7. Section F.3. **Weighing (JUN 17)** is deleted in its entirety and the following inserted for superalloys:

**Section F.3. Weighing (Superalloys) (APR 25)**

- a. No outweighing of material will be performed by the Government. The Government's weights of record shall govern and will be used for payment purposes. The Customer may elect to have a representative present to witness the outloading.
- b. Weight certificates shall be provided at the expense of the Government.
- c. In the event that any broken containers are detected at time of shipment, these will be overpackaged by the Government at the Government's expense prior to outloading. If no loss is discernible, the weight of record with the Government shall govern for that item and shall be final for payment.
8. Section F.4. **Weight Discrepancy (JUN 17)** applies to superalloys material and the text of this clause is included below:

**Section F.4. Weight Discrepancy (Superalloys) (APR 25)**

- a. If the Customer's weights for the material received vary from the Government's certified weights by more than one-half of one percent, the Customer may give notice of such difference to the Stockpile Sales Officer within two (2) working days (exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and Government holidays) after receipt of the material at the destination, requesting that the material be reweighed. In that case, the Customer shall segregate the shipment in question and hold it intact pending reweighing. The entire shipment shall be reweighed by the Customer at its expense, in the presence of and in the manner approved by a Government representative, using scales approved by the Government representative. If the weight varies from the Government's certified weight by greater than one-half of one percent, plus or minus, that weight shall govern for payment purposes. If the weight determined by reweighing does not vary from the Government's certified weight by greater than one-half of one percent, plus or minus, the Government's certified weight shall be final for payment purposes.
  - b. No adjustment shall be considered or made in accordance with the above paragraph unless notice is given by the Customer to the Stockpile Sales Officer within the time specified above and all other requirements of the paragraph are complied with.
9. Section **F.6. Adjustment for Variation in Quantity or Weight (APR 25)** does not apply to superalloys and is deleted in its entirety.
10. The reference to Section **I.10. Special Certifications (JUN 17)** is deleted. There are no special certifications required for superalloys.
11. Except as provided herein, all other terms and conditions of **DLA-Stockpile Materials-001-(Auction)** remain unchanged and in full force and effect. The Bidder must acknowledge receipt of this Amendment by checking the box below. By acknowledging this Amendment, the Bidder accepts the terms and conditions of Auction Solicitation **DLA-Stockpile Materials-001-(Auction)**, as amended by this Amendment No. 001 (Superalloys) and the Acceptance Letter.
