6. Facilitate planning, control, monitoring, corrective action, auditing and review of activities to ensure conformance with Environmental, Safety and Occupational Health Policy and ESOHMS.
7. Incorporate changes in the Facility's Environmental, Safety and Occupational Health Management System (ESOHMS) as appropriate.
8. Demonstrate continual improvement to the ESOHMS
